Grammar: Past simple irregular verbs (affirmative, interrogative and negative form), past continuous, past simple vs past continuous.

“The Brown Lady of Raynham Hall”

Unit 8: “Our beautiful world”

- Talk about places;
- Make comparisons;

Grammar: Articles, comparative adjectives (more or adjective + er), as...as, less (than), superlative adjectives (the most or the adjective + est).

Reading: “Mind the gap! Your gap year specialists”

“Marmore Falls”

Unit 9: “A bright future!”

- Talk about jobs;
- Talk about intentions and predictions;
- Talk about future arrangements.

Grammar: be going to (intentions/ predictions), present continuous (future arrangements).

Reading: “5 New year’s resolutions to try this year!”

“Is <<follow your passion>> good advice?”

Unit 10: “In the city!”

- Talk about cities;
- Talk about the future;
- Talk about real conditions.

Grammar: will (predictions and future facts), will (offers, promises, spontaneous decisions), first conditional, when/as soon as/ unless.

Reading: “Life on Mars: will we live on the Red Planet?”

“China’s bike-sharing boom”

Unit 11: “Sport for all!”

- Talk about experiences.

Grammar: Present perfect (affirmative, interrogative and negative form), present perfect with ever and never; present perfect vs past simple.

Reading: “Serena Williams: the USA’s greatest sportsperson?”

Unit 12: “What a feeling!”

- Talk about feelings;
- Talk about recent actions.

Grammar: Present perfect with just, yet, already

Reading: “The perils of procrastination”
